## What is WestieMed?

WestieMed, Inc., is an internet-based, all-volunteer, non-profit corporation founded in 2000 to distribute financial aid to injured or ill rescue Westies.

*Experiencing the feeling of pride and joy while watching rescued Westies thrive physically and emotionally in new loving adoptive homes is a powerful reward for anyone involved in rescue.*

*Sadly, due to the high cost of veterinary care and the limited budgets of most rescuers, not all rescued Westies are given an opportunity for restored health and a better life. Rescuers are often placed in the difficult position of making decisions based solely on available resources.*

*WestieMed strives to offer financial assistance to rescuers nationwide, allowing them to foster, rehabilitate and nurture as many Westies in rescue situations as possible, worry free of monetary constraints.*

## Which Westies Qualify for Help?

- The Westie requires non-routine medical treatment and is in a rescue situation or recently adopted.
- Local rescue funds are not available or are insufficient.
- A licensed veterinarian has assessed all injuries and ailments and has determined that the Westie has a chance for a good quality of life.
- The Westie is not terminally ill.
- The Westie is/will be spayed or neutered.
- Funding for the treatment of congenital orthopedic conditions will be considered in some cases.
- Established pets will not be funded; however, a Westie that was recently placed in an adoptive home may be eligible for funding in some cases.
- There is no age limit – each case will be judged as to quality of future life for that Westie.
- Applications must be submitted no later than 60 days after incurring the expense.
